INDIA PAVILION AT TRANSRUSSIA 2027
16 – 18 MARCH 2027: CROCUS EXPO, PAVILION 3, MOSCOW, RUSSIA

Bilateral commercial ties between India and the Russian Federation are undergoing an unprecedented structural expansion. The bilateral trade volume has reached nearly US\$ 60 Billion for the 2025–26 cycle, marking a monumental four-fold increase over the preceding five years. During the recent India-Russia Inter-Governmental Commission session, both nations collectively committed to a visionary target of US\$ 100 Billion in bilateral trade by 2030. Indian exports to Russia stand at approx. US\$ 3.0 to US\$ 4.5 Billion annually, heavily led by machinery, mechanical appliances, pharmaceuticals, and organic chemicals. The unprecedented surge in trade value has created acute infrastructural demand for sophisticated, alternative logistics solutions. Traditional shipping lanes face geopolitical bottlenecks, positioning multi-modal transport and technology integration as the primary enablers of uninterrupted bilateral commerce.

In this background, Services Export Promotion Council with the support of Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India is organizing an India Pavilion at TransRussia Exhibition from 16 – 18 March 2027 at Pavilion 3, Crocus Expo International Exhibition Centre, Moscow Russia.
